

Antipodean Palette

Art Exhibition

Conditions of Entry

- 1. Open to all practicing artists actively involved in art or design, in a full or part-time capacity, or are current members of an art society, having had work sold or exhibited in solo or group exhibitions.
- 2. The 'Antipodean Palette' is an open theme exhibition.
- 3. Interested artists must complete the online entry form, available through the GACL website & submit a max 200 word artist statement including images of the works they wish to submit.
- 4. All artist submissions will be reviewed by a panel of GACL committee members.
- 5. Selection will focus on showcasing a diverse range of artistic disciplines/medium.
- 6. The GACLM reserves the right to reject any entry deemed unsuitable. Decision is final & no correspondence will be entered into.
- 7. The GACL is a non-profit organization. Those selected are expected to contribute an \$80 fee per artist, for promotional costs & gallery hire.
- 8. Work must be original & not previously entered in an 'Antipodean Palette' event.
- 9. Number of entries per artist is dependent on allocated space. Each artist is allocated a 2.5 linear metre wall space in which to exhibit work. This space must also include no less than 40 cm between each piece of work.
- 10. Artists are encouraged to sell their work. The GACL will retain a 15% commission from each sale. Work sold for less than \$100 will not incur a commission.
- 11. Name of artist, medium, title and price must be on the back of each entry.
- 12. Work must be ready to hang with D rings and hanging wire.
- 13. The GACLM will exercise reasonable care in handling artwork but will not accept responsibility for any damage or loss.
- 14. All works must be delivered to the Gallery on the day before the opening and must remain in the Gallery throughout the duration of the exhibition.
- 15. All works must be collected from the Gallery on the final day of the exhibition.
- 16. By signing the entry form, the artist gives permission for the GACL to take photos of artists and their work, including artist statements, for publicity purposes, website and media releases.
- 17. For the exhibition to be professionally run, one artist is required to be on duty at all times. Artists are required to register for roster duty by completing a roster form.
